Many in our church have been praying about possible ministry there since construction began.

Navajo missions: Betty Smith will serve on a week-long mission to the Navajo in June. Betty gives this prayer request: "June 9th I head for my yearly Navajo Mission trip on the Navajo Reservation. This year we will be going to a new place on the eastern side of the reservation, in the Checkerboard area. The church is called Living Waters, in an area near a community called Counselor. We only have 16 missioners going, so we will all be stretched to the max. Our focus will be mainly on VBS, Adult Bible Studies, evangelistic service at night, and lots of cooking and eating. I look forward to seeing what God is going to do with us this year. It is always good. Your prayers are greatly needed and I especially will depend on them. Thank you ahead of time because I know God will be with us."

Day Camp at the Park will happen the mornings of June 18-22 at Richards Park, from 9:00 to noon. The FBC Midland Traveling Rec Team leads this mission with help from some of our youth. The 4-person team includes Alex Bingham from Howard Payne, Brandt Schneider from Texas Tech, Miriam Osterlund from Mary Hardin-Baylor, and Eli Williams from Howard Payne. They will lead Backyard Bible Club at the apartments on June 20. Alex will preach on June 24 and Eli will lead music. The second event that we have coming up is on September 22, 2018 from 9 am-~3pm at FBC, Eden, wherein we are planning a Pastor/Deacon/Wives training. There will be a break-out session for pastors, one for deacons, one for pastors' wives, and one for deacons' wives.
