People will be required to remain in their cars and will not gather in the buildings or parking lot. Our focus will be on getting food to our regular clients. We are not getting much food from Walmart so food boxes will likely be smaller. A shipment from Concho Valley Regional Food Bank is to be delivered April 2nd. *(from George)*
