

Godly Impressions Preschool opened on August 3, 2020. Our new hours of operation are from 7:30-5:30. The new school year starts Tuesday, September 1st. We currently have 35 students enrolled along with 6 teachers and 5 staff members.

Covid-19 has brought on many challenges including the way we do drop-off and pick-up which now must be conducted outside of the facility. A new procedure we've implemented is daily temperature screenings on all staff and children attending. We've had to adjust just about every aspect on how we run a child care program. However, the parents, teachers, and staff have been extraordinarily patient and quick to adapt to all that has been asked of us with the States New Emergency Rules.

We ask the church to pray for the health of all the individuals we serve and love on.
