Message from the Pastor: Living your faith in front of your family by Jeff Quattlebaum

Val had wonderful memories of days he had spent at his great-grandfather's old farmhouse. They had shared many delicious meals there with platters piled high with Granny's fried chicken and biscuits. Val remembered playing checkers on the porch with Grandpa, shelling peas with Granny, taking Sunday afternoon naps in front of the fireplace, and the laughter as uncles, aunts, and cousins played tag and ate Grandpa's famous hand-churned ice cream.

But the times that still made him tear up were the memories of the mornings he would walk into the kitchen and see his Grandpa reading his dog-eared Bible. The countless times he pulled Val close and prayed for him with tears on his cheeks. The days when he heard Granny singing hymns as she worked in the kitchen. There was a sweet security in those moments.

His great-grandparents had gone to Heaven many years ago, but every time Val walked through the front door of that house, warm memories wrapped around him as if Granny had draped one of her handmade quilts around his shoulders. Val's recollections of his grandparents were precious. When they died, they left him a little money and some gorgeous heirloom furniture that Grandpa had made, but Val considered the best treasures were that they had taught him by example about life, Jesus, and love.

On Friday, May 21st, I had the privilege of giving words of encouragement at a high school graduation. I gave my speech and then sat through the rest of the ceremony listening, celebrating, and praying for each of the high school seniors as they received their diplomas. My thoughts immediately went to the passage in Deuteronomy 11 where Moses was reminding the Children of Israel to teach their families the ways of God:

Place these words on your hearts. Get them deep inside you.

Tie them on your hands and foreheads as a reminder. Teach them to your children.

Talk about them wherever you are, sitting at home or walking in the street;

talk about them from the time you get up in the morning

until you fall into bed at night.

Deuteronomy 11:18-19 (The Message)

In 1957, Willie Nelson wrote a song called Family Bible. The third verse says, "Now this old world of ours is filled with troubles. This old world would also better be, if we'd found more Bibles on the tables and mothers singing Rock of Ages cleft for me." Jesus teaches us that if we build our lives and family on Him, then no matter the storms, we will be able to stand (Matthew 7:24-25).

What will your loved ones remember about you? Will they talk about a man or woman who loved God? Will they remember your faithful example? In the midst of our busy days, take time to live your faith in front of your family. Remember what the old proverb says, "Point your kids in the right direction – when they are old they won't be lost (Proverbs 22:6 The Message). That will be the most cherished inheritance you could ever leave them.
