#### Section IV Church Clerk, current provisions in Article II of the Bylaws:

The Church Clerk's term of office shall be one year from October 1 through September 30 each calendar year.

**Proposed change:** (The changes or additions are marked out or in *italics*.)

The Church Clerk's term of office shall be one year from October 1 through September 30 each calendar year, with the term renewable each year by vote of the church at the September business meeting.

# Section V Church Treasurer, current provisions in Article II of the Bylaws:

The Treasurer's term of office shall be one year from October 1 through September 30 each calendar year.

#### **Proposed change:**

The Treasurer's term of office shall be one year from October 1 through September 30 each calendar year, with the term renewable each year by vote of the church at the September business meeting.

#### Section VI Parliamentarian, current provisions in Article II of the Bylaws:

Term of office: One year, after which the Parliamentarian may be re-nominated and may serve a maximum of three (3) consecutive years, after which one (1) year must pass before an individual may serve as Parliamentarian again.

#### **Proposed change:**

Term of office: The Parliamentarian's term of office shall be one year from October 1 through September 30, with the term renewable each year by vote of the church at the September business meeting.

#### Section VII Church Trustees, current provisions in Article II of the Bylaws:

Term of Office: Each individual Trustee shall serve three years on a rotating system, after which one year must pass before the individual may serve as a Trustee again.

#### **Proposed change:**

Term of Office: Each individual Trustee shall serve three years on a rotating system, after which one year must pass before the individual may serve as a Trustee again. Each Trustee's term of office shall be one year from October 1 through September 30, with the term renewable each year by vote of the church at the September business meeting.
